

AGE

Ohio's Latino registered voters tend to be younger than non-Latinos with 18-24 year olds comprising 18% of registered Latinos, compared to 10% of non-Latinos. Similarly, 26% of Latino registered voters are 25-34 year olds, compared to 17% of non-Latinos. In contrast, nearly one-half of non-Latino registered voters are 50 and older (49%), compared to 29% of Latinos.



LATINOS IN OHIO ELECTED OFFICE

In 2015, 15 Latinos served in elected office in Ohio, with 87% serving at the local level, including county, municipal, school board, judicial and law enforcement, and special district officials. Between 1996 and 2015, there was a fivefold increase in the number of Latino elected officials in the state, which grew from three to 15.
