Our national and local funding is directed toward:

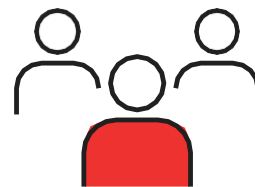
- Auto and roadway safety

- Education initiatives for underserved individuals that focus on post-secondary education and obtaining skills and credentials

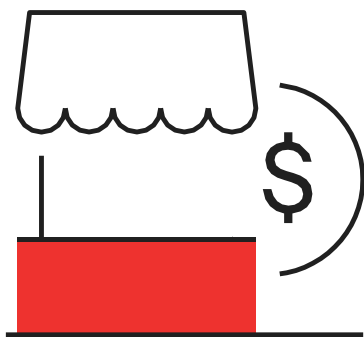


Community Development

Matching Gift

Financial Foundation

This hour-long interactive forum is hosted by State Farm agents to help educate customers on five fundamental areas that are key to understanding the basics of personal finance: setting goals, building a budget, saving money, managing debt and understanding credit.

Good Neighbor Grant[®]

State Farm Companies Foundation awards a \$500 grant on behalf of each eligible State Farm employee, agent, or retiree, who volunteers a minimum of 40 hours per calendar year to an eligible nonprofit organization. A team of State Farm employees, agents and retirees is also eligible to apply.
