#### **Disaster Readiness**

- Every 8 minutes, the Red Cross responds to a disaster in the United States, mostly house fires in local neighborhoods and communities
- Tropical storms, tornadoes, hurricanes, wildfires, floods, aviation accidents, school shootings, and terrorist events

Not a government agency – fundamental principle of Independence
