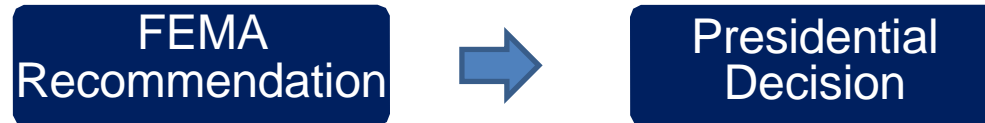

Disaster Declarations: Declaring a Disaster



Joint Field Office

- Established after a disaster is declared by the President
- Multiagency coordination center
- Built and staffed within three days

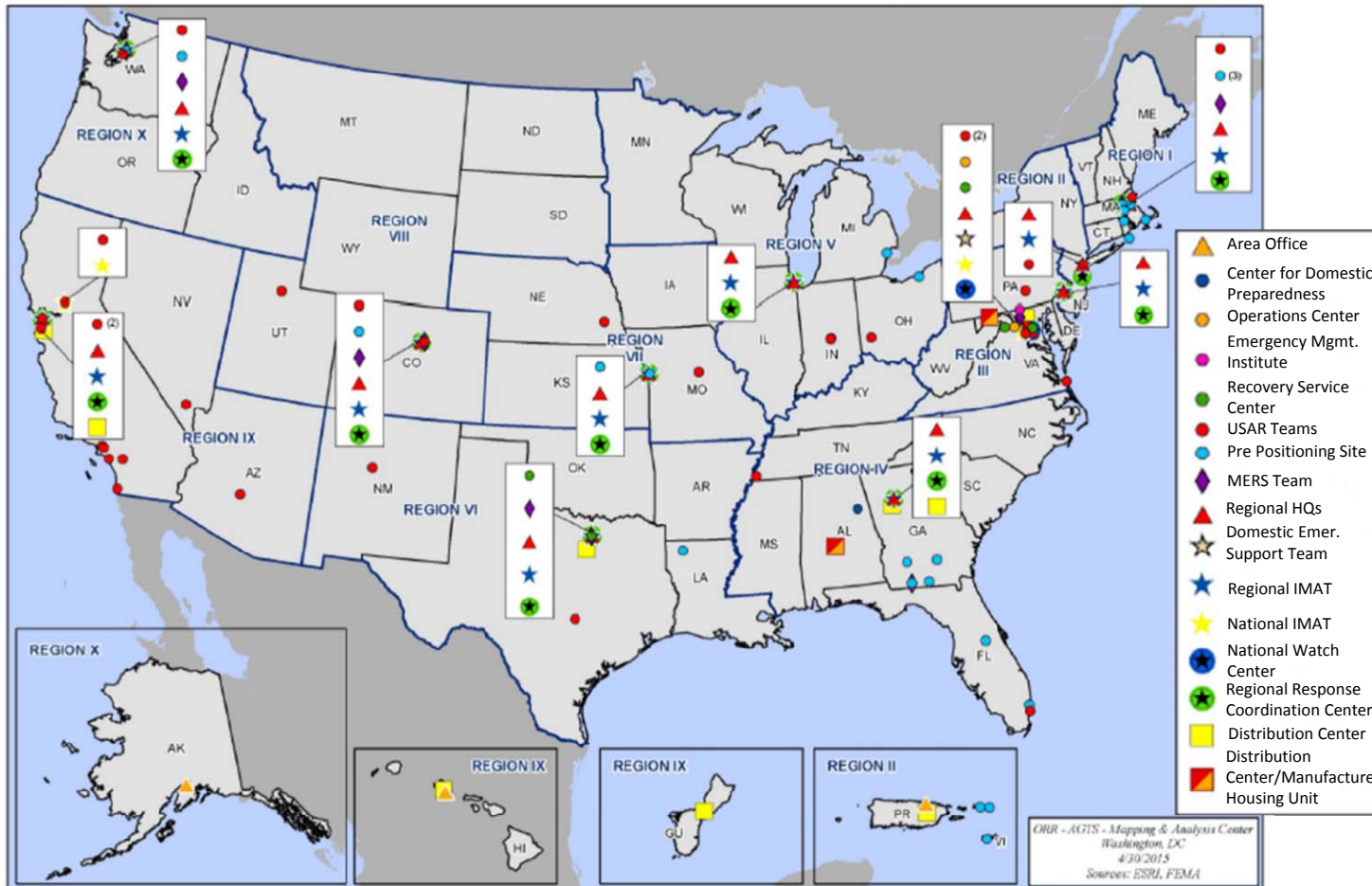
State/Tribal Coordinating Officer

- Appointed by the governor or tribal leader
- Coordinates local/tribal response and recovery operations

Federal Coordinating Officer

- Appointed by FEMA on behalf of the President
- Coordinates federal assistance

- 10 Regional and 3 National Incident Management Assistance Teams
- 28 Urban Search and Rescue Teams
- 6 Mobile Emergency Response Support Teams
- 8 Distribution Centers

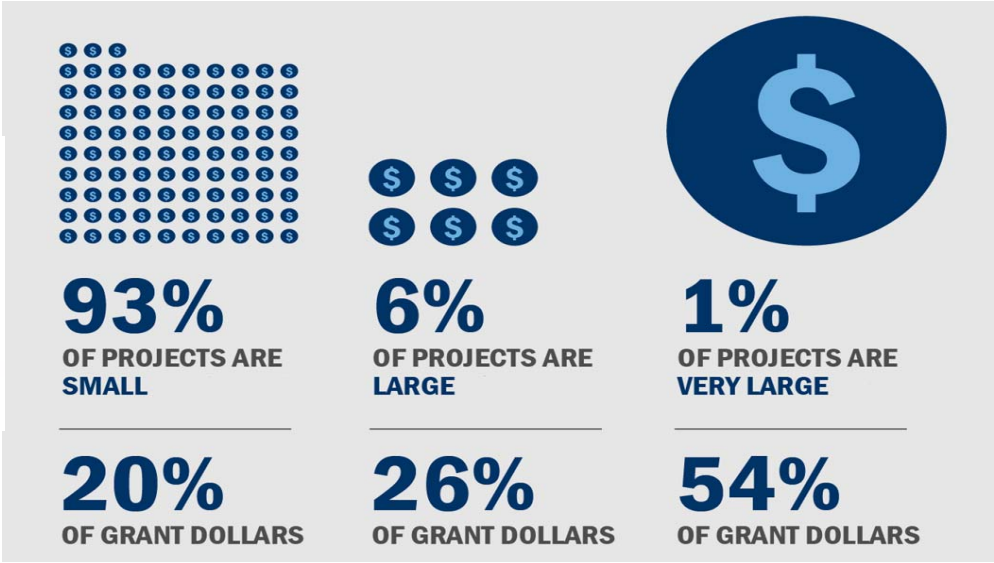
Recovery- Individual Assistance



- Individuals and Households Program
 - Maximum Grant is \$33,300
 - Average Grant over the last 10 calendar years is approximately \$4,100
- Disaster Case Management Grant Program
- Crisis Counseling Grant Program
- Unemployment Assistance Grant Program
- Legal Services Grant Program
- Disaster Survivor Assistance Teams
- Mass Care/Voluntary Agencies Liaisons

Top Reasons for Individual Assistance Recoupment*

1. Occupancy not verified

2. Duplication of Benefits with Household Member

3. House Assistance Overpayment: Home Repair/Rental Assistance

4. Duplication of Benefits with Insurance

5. Identity Verification Failure

6. Not Primary Resident

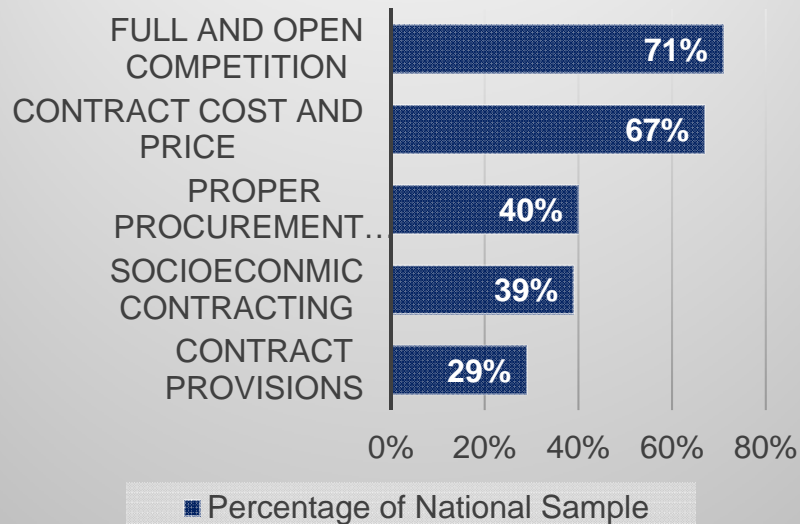
Account for 69% of all IA Recoupments

Account for 86% of all IA Recoupments

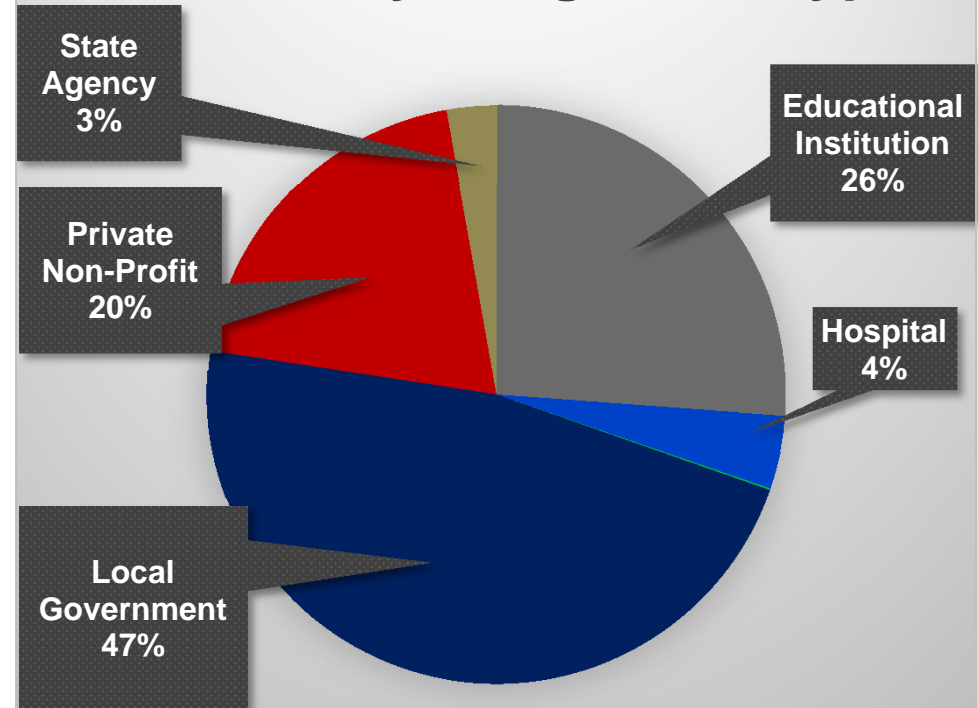
