WASHINGTON, D.C. – The National Association of Latino Elected and Appointed Officials (NALEO) Educational Fund today released the following statement from Chief Executive Officer Arturo Vargas ahead of the initial hearing by the House Committee on Homeland Security regarding efforts to impeach U.S. Secretary of Homeland Security Alejandro Mayorkas:

"We are disappointed with the unconstructive and divisive actions by the U.S. House of Representatives to revive impeachment efforts against Secretary of Homeland Security Alejandro Mayorkas.
